It can be used in historic preservation, and is made from natural materials, which makes it wonderful for ecologically friendly building. Patriot LimePaint is supplied as a dry powder, where water is added on site.

Traces of this historic wash/stain have been found as early as the 14th century and almost every historic brick structure we look at has remnants of this protective and decorative wash. Mineral Paint

Developed in Europe during the 19th century, mineral based (also known as waterglass or potassium silicate) paints have been used to decorate the exterior and interior of masonry buildings throughout the world. Virginia Lime Works MineralPaint is extremely vapor permeable and is a great compliment to exterior stuccos (both cement and lime based).

Distemper KALSOMINE

If you've ever visited Virginia Lime Works, you've seen Distemper in action. Also known as "Soft Distemper," Calcimine, or "Soft" Calcimine, Virginia Lime Works Distemper/Kalsomine is a mixture of whiting (chalk), glue size, pigment, and water. Traditionally Distempers were used to paint hot (or newly) plastered walls, and in particular, decorative plasterwork such as cornices. The nature of distempers allow them to be washed off using hot water, which would allow decorative work such as ceiling roses, medallions, and cornices to be repainted without losing detail due to build up.
